

MINUTES OF SEVEN VALLEYS BOROUGH
COUNCIL MEETING
Monday, June 1, 2015

Council President John A. McDonald called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the Salute to the Flag. Those in attendance in addition to Mr. McDonald were Council members Gregory W. Kinard, William H. Stiles, II (7:44), Zachary W. Stiles and Edwin E. Zeigler, Mayor Douglas J. Wagner, Secretary, Cheryl D. Bahn and Solicitor, D. Michael Craley. Council members David M. Dietrich and Rebecca Kinard were absent from the meeting. The meeting was held at the Seven Valleys Fire Company, 35 Main St, in Seven Valleys Borough.

President McDonald declared the minutes of the May 4, 2015 meeting approved as circulated.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

1. There have been several complaints regarding the dogs at 134 Main St barking late at night. The Owners requested and were given an extension to comply with the Ordinance until after the July 6th Council Meeting thereby allowing Mr. Weidman three months until July 16, 2015 to come into compliance unless there were additional complaints or problems that come to Council regarding the animals on the property. Wayne has sent an enforcement notice under The Seven Valleys Borough Code 39-4 addressing the barking. Mr. Craley also noted that the situation could be addressed by section 39-3 of the same code which requires a night time enclosure not an open air enclosure.
2. Mr. Craley reported on The State Workers Compensation Insurance Fund. They are asking that a complete listing of participant be provided for each event where volunteers are used by a Fire Company. The Seven Valleys Borough Code allows participation as long as an officer of the Fire Company authorizes participation at an event, all volunteers are covered under the Borough's Insurance.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Curb painting will be starting soon.
2. The patch work is completed on South Street, it should give us another year. If we would tar and chip it twice in immediate succession we could possibly get two or three years out of it.
3. Two bad spots were patched on Maple St to give us time to get prices on an appropriate repair. The patch should stop the deterioration for now. An outside company should do the repairs. John will check into the cost to do the work.
4. John will also try to obtain estimates to do work on South Street for the next meeting.
5. John will also arrange to have the storm drains cleaned out.
