

MINUTES OF SEVEN VALLEYS BOROUGH
COUNCIL MEETING
Monday, June 3, 2019

Council Vice-President Gregory W. Kinard called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the Salute to the Flag. Those in attendance in addition to Mr. Kinard were Council members, Rebecca A. Kinard, Gary L. Landis and John J. Neal; Mayor Douglas Wagner, Secretary Cheryl D. Bahn and Solicitor D. Michael Craley. John McDonald, William Stiles and Zachary Stiles were absent from the meeting. The meeting was held at the Seven Valleys Fire Company, 35 Main St, in Seven Valleys Borough.

Hearing no corrections, Vice-President Gregory W. Kinard declared the minutes of the May 6, 2019 meeting approved as circulated.

PUBLIC COMMENT

1. Lieutenant Joseph P. Spingler | Station Commander, Pennsylvania State Police | Troop J, York was present to introduce himself. Council has noticed the Police presence in the Borough. He ran the stats for Seven Valleys since the beginning of the year and reported 1 assault, 1 warrant detail, 2 nuisances, 1 drug arrest, 8 crashes and 30 Traffic stops.
Discussion began regarding the stop sign at the bridge that the state placed there about 3 years ago to try to stop incidents at the bridge. The state also placed signs to route trucks away from the bridge. The Mayor is working with Sen Kristen Phillips-Hill, York County Parks and Penn DOT to try to find a solution. While it is a two-lane bridge many treat it as a one lane bridge. Perhaps a yield to oncoming traffic on both sides would solve the problem.
The Mayor is looking towards a meeting with the principals in the near future.
