

MINUTES OF SEVEN VALLEYS BOROUGH
COUNCIL MEETING
Wednesday, July 6, 2011

Council Vice-President John A. McDonald called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the Salute to the Flag. Those in attendance in addition to Mr. McDonald were Council members Rebecca Kinard , Robin L. Venable and Edwin E. Zeigler, Mayor Steven A. Venable, Secretary Cheryl D. Bahn and Solicitor D. Michael Craley. Lynn W. Krebs, Gregory W. Kinard and Larry E. Garland were absent from the meeting. The meeting was held at the Seven Valleys Fire Company, 35 Main St, in Seven Valleys Borough.

Hearing no corrections, Vice-President McDonald declared the minutes of the June 6, 2011 meeting approved as circulated.

SOLICITOR'S PORTION OF THE MEETING

1. Mr. Craley indicated that The Storm Water Ordinance update will be ready for enactment at the October Council Meeting. He and JRH are working together.
2. Mr. Craley has drafted changes to the Refuse Collection Ordinance. He has consulted Penn Waste . The Ordinance will be ready to adopt at the October meeting.
3. GWM Update – An extension is needed from GWM Properties as the 90 days for approval of the land development plan would be July 19th. The Zoning Hearing for the property will be held July 27th.
4. Council will need to appoint a replacement to the vacancy left by Lynn Krebs within 30 days. The next Council Meeting will be within the 30 day window. Council will look for a replacement to be appointed at the next meeting. The appointment would be until the end of this year. Since the resignation is before September 1st, there is time for the position to be filled at the general election. The Elections office will be notified of the two-year vacancy.
5. Council may re-organize after the appointment.
6. There is also need for an appointment to the Zoning Hearing Board. Council will look for a replacement to be appointed at the next meeting. A member of the Planning Commission may not be a member of the Zoning Hearing Board.
