

MINUTES OF SEVEN VALLEYS BOROUGH
COUNCIL MEETING
Monday, June 2, 2014

Council President John A. McDonald called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the Salute to the Flag. Those in attendance in addition to Mr. McDonald were Council members David M. Dietrich, Gregory W. Kinard, Rebecca Kinard, William H. Stiles, II, Zachary W. Stiles and Edwin E. Zeigler, Secretary, Cheryl D. Bahn and Solicitor, D. Michael Craley. Mayor Douglas J. Wagner, was absent from the meeting. The meeting was held at the Seven Valleys Fire Company, 35 Main St, in Seven Valleys Borough.

President McDonald declared the minutes of the May 5, 2014 meeting approved as circulated.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Motion made by W. Stiles/R. Kinard to authorize adoption of Resolution #2-2014 to authorize the filing of applications for funds with the YCPC for the 2015-2017 CDBG Program, as well as signature of the two applications. Motion carried unanimously.

SOLICITOR'S PORTION OF THE MEETING

Mr. Craley reviewed the letter received from PA Dept of Labor concerning the Appeal Case of David Miller – The Decision and Order of the Worker' Compensation Judge is hereby AFFIRMED. North Codorus' Joinder Petition is denied. This does not affect the Borough as the fire fighter was responding for North Codorus Township not Seven Valleys.

2. Curb painting
3. The Borough has completed the sign reflectivity. We need (2) 25 mph signs and (2) stop signs. They will be ordered and installed. As street signs are replaced, they will be updated according guidelines at the time of replacement.
4. As of 5/28th property owners were billed for snow removal services. 12 of the 15 properties have paid. Two have not paid. One was invoiced in error. John will talk to the two owners if possible as a follow up to the Borough' Invoice. Mr. Craley will then place liens on the properties still outstanding.
