Council President John A. McDonald called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the Salute to the Flag. Those in attendance in addition to Mr. McDonald were Council members David M. Wagner were absent from the meeting. The meeting was held at the Seven Valleys Fire Company, 35 Main St, in Seven Valleys Borough.

3. EMS Update - The York County 911's CAD system upgrade is well underway. It is expected to go-live October 29th. Our EMS has built their responses to specify up to 3rd due for ALS & BLS stations and then revert to proximity dispatch for 4th due and beyond. The CAD administrator was notified that the plan is to continue as written.

NEW BUSINESS

1. **Motion** by R. Kinard/Stiles to authorized signature of 2014 Contract with the York County SPCA at a cost of \$259.00. Motion carried unanimously.
2. **Motion** by Dietrich/G. Kinard to authorize signature of 2014 Contract with Michelle Klugh, for Animal Control Services. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Phillip Leitma, ISO Community Hazard Mitigation is currently working on updating the

ISO fire insurance classification for Seven Valleys Borough. The last update was in 1996. He plans to meet with the Fire Company.

4. A NCT resident in Hanover Junction, Rick McDaniel, is interested in connecting to the public sewer via the line that serves the two EDU at Hanover Junction Train Station. He has requested that NCT explore the possibility of arranging connection for his property and his parents property to the public sewer. The line is currently a private lateral owned by York County/York County Parks and connected to Seven Valley's system. The lateral/main is 8" by about one mile and be completely gravity driven. The York County Parks would be very receptive to doing what they can to provide public sewer service to Rick. Seven Valleys Borough does have 7 EDU available. The County's line would need to be televised and converted from a private lateral to a public sewer line prior to any other connections taking place. NCT is in favor of extending the public sewer although at this point I don't know if anyone fully understands what this may entail. NCT thought is that they would want to extend the line in such a way that not only Rick but other residents in Hanover Junction who might need or want to connect to public sewer, provided the required EDUs were available. It may be that North Codorus Township would need to accept responsibility for the line to the Seven Valleys Borough line.

Mark Derr, NCT Manager has contacted both the Borough and the STYCSA requesting information and discussion. No actual request has been made.
