Venable were absent from the meeting. The meeting was held at the Seven Valleys Fire Company, 35 Main St, in Seven Valleys Borough.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Keith Smith, Seven Valleys Fire Company presented Council with an itemized bill for work that had been done to make the small meeting room rest room handicap accessible. The cost was \$444.51. After review of the bill by Mr. McDonald, items that not associated with the bathroom were deducted making the total cost \$350.00. Per the August meeting of Council, a check in that amount will be sent to the Fire Company.
2. At the Borough's request, Penn Dot painted double yellow lines on Maple Street. Many people have expressed their thanks to the Borough for finding a way to have this work done.

NEW BUSINESS

1. **Motion** made by Zeigler/Dietrich to set the date for Trick or Treat Trick as Wednesday, October 31, 2012 from 6 pm-8 pm. Motion carried unanimously.
Mr. McDonald will purchase or find donations for the food and items needed for the Drop-in Social to be held at Christian Liberty Fellowship. Since it is a Bingo night, he will need help to cook the hot dogs.
2. Seven Valleys Borough Weeks at the 29th edition of Christmas Magic – A Festival of Lights will be November 23–December 14 and December 26-31 Rocky Ridge County Park
3. Coupon is redeemable for Buy One, Get One Free Admission-Maximum is 2 free regular admissions. The coupon is valid only for 2012 program - Coupon is good for a one-time use. The Coupon will be distributed in the Borough Newsletter and on the Borough website.
4. Mr. Dietrich will ask Borough Businesses if they are interested in using the Borough Newsletter for placement of a small ad for their business. He will get information to the Secretary in two weeks. The Newsletter will be delivered in late September. Mrs. Kinard will see that Rodney delivers the papers.
5. Mr. McDonald has found several gallons of old Traffic Line paint in the Borough's Storage Shed. He will dispose of the paint or see if another organization can make use of the paint.
