ITEMS OF INTEREST ABOUT SEVEN VALLEYS

Seven Valleys Borough was incorporated on August 23, 1892.

There are 2.16 miles of Borough roads, not including state highways.

The population per the 2000 census is 492.

Estimated Revenues for 2010 - \$94,194.

2010 Taxes: Earned Income Tax Rate is 1/2% (\$44,800), the Real Estate Tax Rate is .60 mills (\$13,200) and the Real Estate Transfer Tax Rate is 1/2% (\$3,000)

Seven Valleys Borough annually allocates financial aid to the following organizations:

- Seven Valleys Volunteer Fire Company
 - Windy Hill Senior Center
 - Village Library
 - Tri-Community Ambulance Association
- Council urges residents to utilize their services and/or support their activities.

BOROUGH OPERATIONS: The day-to-day operations of the BOROUGH are handled by the Borough Secretary who in turn reports to the Borough Council. All matters are discussed and acted upon, if necessary, at the regular monthly meeting. These meetings are always open to the public. If there is a matter that you would like to bring before council, please contact the Borough Secretary.

POLICE SERVICE: Seven Valleys depends on the Pa State Police for police service. To contact the police dial 911.

DISTRICT MAGISTRATE: Seven Valleys Borough is in Magisterial District 19-3-6, which is presided over by District Justice Kim S. Leppo. His office is located at 4824 Walters Hatchery Road , Spring Grove, PA 17362. (225-3301)

FIRE PROTECTION: This service is provided by the Community Volunteer Fire Company located on Main Street in the Borough. In an emergency, dial 911.

PLANNING COMMISSION: When required, the Planning Commission meets on the 3rd Tuesday of the month, at 7:00 pm in the Fire Hall. The present commission members are Wayne Kessler, Chair, Cathy M. Ensor, Larry E Garland, John A. McDonald, and and John A Patterson II .

ZONING HEARING BOARD: When needed, the board meets at 7:00 PM, at the Fire Hall, as arranged and advertised. The present Board Members are Beth Kinard , Beverly Kunkle and Denton Guise. Ray A Dietrich, Jr. is the alternate.

BUILDING/USE PERMITS: Seven Valleys Borough has both a Zoning Ordinance and a Land Development and Subdivision Ordinance that require the use of Building and Use Permits. The Ordinances are administered by the Borough Zoning Officer and Uniform Construction Code Officer, Wayne Smith 225-0650, who issues all permits.
