WEEDS

During the late summer, the weeds and grass between the curb and the sidewalk and between the sidewalk and the road become quite plentiful in the Borough. Several residents have complained about the presence of this vegetation as it is unlawful according to the Seven Valleys Borough Code. If you have any of this type of vegetation growing in front of your property please comply with the Code by removing the vegetation. Thank you.

SNOW REMOVAL

Part of Seven Valleys Borough Code indicates that Snow removed from your property

shall not be thrown into the street. Please be considerate of motorists who may face icy roads. The addition of snow thrown into the streets is dangerous and illegal.

The Snow Removal Ordinance also requires that all property owners and tenants remove snow and ice from their sidewalks and walkways within 24 hours from when the snow stops falling. Enough snow and ice shall be removed to allow a clear path for pedestrian traffic. Just one property owner leaving snow on the sidewalks make is dangerous for other residents

When it is apparent that there will be an accumulation of snow, residents are asked to park off street so that the snow removal contractor can do an efficient job of clearing the streets. Your cooperation is appreciated.

UPDATES TO THE BOROUGH CODE

1. Stormwater Management Chapter 101

All regulated activities and all activities that may affect stormwater runoff, including land development and earth disturbance activity, are subject to regulation by this Chapter. It will be necessary to fill out a Stormwater Management Application when applying for a building/zoning permit to be sure that stormwater issues are addressed.

2. SECTION 105-3 OF THE SEVEN VALLEYS CODE TO PROHIBIT OBSTRUCTIONS TO SIDEWALKS No person or persons shall place, keep or cause to be placed or kept upon any sidewalk or footwalk in the Borough of Seven Valleys anything which will restrict or impair pedestrians using the sidewalk or footwalk or anything which will alter or inhibit water flow on or from the sidewalk or footwalk.
