# **STREET SWEEPING**

Street sweeping of Borough streets is scheduled to <u>begin</u> at **7:00 A.M.** on **Tuesday**, <u>April **23**</u>, 2024.

Please <u>park off-street</u> until the street sweeper has passed your home allowing a thorough cleaning of the roadways.

If you have any loose stones/antiskid materials on your sidewalk left from winter snow/ice control, please sweep the material onto the side of the street for pick up by the street sweeper.

Rain date is Wednesday, April 24th, and will apply only if water is running along the street gutters. If there is only light rain or drizzle, street sweeping will take place on the scheduled day of April 23rd.

#### SUMP PUMPS AND STORMWATER IMPACTING SEWER TREATMENT

Did you know that the connection of sump pumps and roof downspouts not only cause an overload on the sewer collection system and treatment plant, but it also costs the customer to treat the clean water, and that it is illegal to have either tied into your sewer lateral (pipe) leading from your property?

It has been observed by the Springfield Township York County Sewer Authority (STYCSA) that there is an increased amount of "inflow" (direct flow of stormwater entering the sewer system) during rain events, which is an indication that sump pumps and/or roof downspouts are tied directly into the sewer system. This not only causes an overload on the collection and treatment system, but is costly to you, the customer, to be treating the additional (clean) water.

What can you do to help correct this issue? First, if you have a sump pump, check to see where the pipe discharges. You should be able to see the end of the pipe outside your home, typically in a lawn area or at the street curb. Second, check your roof downspouts, do you see where they discharge onto the outside surface? If the downspouts extend into the outside surface or into the building, they most likely are connected to the sewer system. Finally, inspect the sewer piping in your home to verify that sump pump or roof downspouts are not connect to the sewer line.

If you are not sure, or you suspect, that your sump pump and/or roof drains are connected to the sewer system, but need assistance to verify, please contact the Borough at 717-309-8033 or email contact@sevenvalleysborough.com, and a free inspection will be scheduled. Note that compliance is the goal of the STYCSA and Seven Valleys Borough and that you will **not** be fined or assessed any penalty if you request an inspection and a violation is discovered.

## **MAINTAINING VEGETATION: GRASS, WEEDS & TREES**

**Bushes, hedges, shrubs** and other **ornamental flowers** and vegetation cannot overhang on sidewalks or streets. Trees that overhang public sidewalks must be kept trimmed to a **minimum clearance of 10 feet**.

Grass, weeds, and similar noxious vegetation cannot exceed a height of 12 inches.
